TL;DR

There are basically two goals.

First is to provide services to people. OpenSource (mostly FOSS) based on principal of decentralization and federation. Which means instead of being yet another silo service provider we use tools that allow for creating huge network of service providers (non-profit like ours, individuals, or even commercial). This allows all of them to interact with eachother, which gives users freedom of choice of their provider (or becoming one themselves) without loosing connection to others who have choosen other providers.

The second goal is to encourage people to join us in running similar platforms open for people to use, as this will grow the network open to an avarage joe. In long run we are planning to form a community of service providers, help other collectives with setup, work together on deployment scripts , release provision bundle that could spin such platform in automated fashion etc. We are just one small little fish in great ocean working with other similar initiatives around the world in the struggle to take (disroot) the power back to users in decentralized fashion.
